In the Name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.

After Christ was baptized, the first words that He said were: 'Repent for the Kingdom of Heaven is at hand'. Why? Because after we have been baptized, we are always tempted and the only way to end temptation is to repent.

The effects of temptation and sin are evident in the world we live in today. Look at what has happened in our beloved Ukraine. Why was there a maidan revolution during the time of theophany just a few short years ago? It was because the very individuals who have been put in positions of power by the people of Ukraine turned against the people. They sold Ukraine for power, money and a place at the feet of a foreign dictator who continues even to this day to undermine hard fought freedom that has been paid for with blood, sweat, tears and millions of Ukrainian lives.

Once again sin and corruption has put in peril not just freedom but the very lives of pious, brave and God loving people. This is all a result of temptation and lack of humility. It is a result of refusal to come to Christ. A refusal to come to repentance and realize that temporal wealth and power do not serve or bring salvation to our immortal soul.
