The children that live at these orphanages are living with the aftereffects of the Chornobyl Nuclear Accident of 1986. The children in these two orphanages are truly those who are most overlooked, the most in need. These children may have cancer, genetic birth defects and complications, heart anomalies and immune deficiencies. Many of them suffer from multiple illnesses, defects and complications. Each orphanage houses between 100-140 children at any given time. We would appreciate any simple arts & crafts items, like beads etc., to take with us for the children at these orphanages.
